Additionally, Ms. Jackson has created a folder in Google Drive that every teacher has access to, so that pictures can be placed in the folders so that there are plenty to choose from when it comes time to create.
3. In addition to this, Amanda Milano has generously offered to use her camera and take pictures at UV events and activities, to ensure we have enough pictures for the yearbook.
